The organization has the expertise of relating with the youth and working towards their holistic empowerment with ample participation from all the stakeholders. Organization has the distinctive know how of making youth participate in our programmes and avail all of our services.

The need for a holistic measure to work with those who are extremely marginalized and subjugated was always felt by the organization.

ICEF is working with various PIA (Project Implementation Agencies) across India (Partial list is given) for the project DDUGKY (Deen Dayal Upadhyay Gramin Kaushal Yojna).

Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) aims to skill rural youth who are poor and provide them with jobs having regular monthly wages or above the minimum wages. It is one of the cluster of initiatives of the Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India that seeks to promote rural livelihoods.

It is a part of the National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM) - the Mission for poverty reduction called Aajeevika. Scheme aimed at creating employment capable youths who are between 18 years to 35 years of age living in Rural areas and who are below poverty line.

This scheme derives importance from its potential to reduce poverty.

ICEF has take the initiative to mobilize the potential beneficiaries by complying to all the eligibility criteria for the scheme and works with various local organisations to get the candidate nominated. ICEF has worked in multiple states as specified by the PIA clients.

The mobilization is focussed on the sanction target for the PIA which includes various demographics like Women, SC, ST and Minority candidates as defined by the GOI quidelines in the sanction order.
